

Your professional development in Technology Education

We are excited to invite you to **Teknosofikum, a course in Technology Education** for teachers in higher education.

Teknosofikum is a collaboration between University of Copenhagen, Royal Danish Academy, Design School Kolding, and IT University of Copenhagen. We also invite participants from other institutions. In Teknosofikum **you will meet colleagues from different fields, think cross disciplinary, share experiences, discuss, and learn new perspectives on technology and teaching.**

Our approach is practice oriented and you will experience a range of relevant topics on how technology can affect your field of work and professional teaching practice. For instance: Regulation of and by Technology, Human-Technology relations, Critical literacy in computing, diversity, design, and ethics in teaching and much more. You select the topics that are most relevant to you and can choose to focus on topics mostly relating to technology, education, or a mix of these. **In the end of the course, you will together with others produce teaching experiments to your own teaching and classes.**

You can participate in one of two ways:

HYBRID: 40 hours. Physical workshops, an online meeting and online self-study
You will join a group of peers from your own and other institutions. This learning path will include 2 days of physical workshop with hands-on development of teaching materials and engaging discussions, an online meeting, and online self-study on the Teknosofikum platform. A detailed program will follow.

ONLINE: 20 hours. Online self-study and online meetings

You will participate in facilitated online meetings together with peers, where you get to discuss teaching and technology. You will also join the Teknosofikum platform, where you will explore various topics about technology and education. A detailed program will follow.
